If you drive a church owned car for private travel you need to be aware of the following:

HM Revenue & Customs has issued revised which are effective from which apply when you use a church owned car for private travel. If a minister/CRCW reimburses the local church at a rate below the advisory rate the excess is treated as taxable income and is liable to PAYE deductions. The new advisory rates are summarised in the following table, all the rates for Petrol and Diesel have unsurprisingly reduced as Covid19 impacts on yet another area of our lives:
